The Chenango County Clerk's Office **DOES NOT MAINTAIN ANY VITAL STATISTICS RECORDS.** **Birth, death and marriage certificates are obtained from the township in which the event took place.** These records can be found with the Registrar of Vital Statistics or Town Clerk where the event occurred. If born or died in the Chenango Memorial Hospital in Norwich, NY, the records are with the City of Norwich. Their telephone number is (607) 334-1230 and address of One City Plaza, Norwich, NY 13815. If the event occurred elsewhere within the County, you need to contact the Registrar of Vital Statistics for the particular township in which the birth, death or marriage took place.

Select the **County Directory** on the Clerk's home page to access the internet version of the Directory of County, Town and Village Officials. The directory will list all Registrars by township.

If you are unsure of the township where the event occurred, you may need to contact the New York State office responsible for maintaining vital records. We have a handout that states:
