Responsibilities/Duties:	Provides comprehensive social work services to clients of the Community Mental Health Clinic, Psychosocial Club Program, or Alcohol and Drug Abuse Services Program. Responsible for performing client evaluations and assessments, formulating treatment plans and conducting individual and group therapy sessions. Coordinate services for clients and may perform intensive case management functions requiring a significant amount of travel using the employee's personal vehicle. Maintain a variety of client records and related documentation and are required to participate in an on-call rotation during clinic hours to respond to crisis situations.
