

Summary of New Agricultural District Layout

New York State Department of Agriculture and Markets states that agricultural districts should maintain an agricultural acreage majority of greater than 50% within them. In other words, of all the land contained within an agricultural district, more than 50% should be used for some kind of agricultural purpose.

In 2010, it became clear to the Chenango County Agriculture and Farmland Protection Board (AFPB) and Chenango County Department of Planning and Development (Planning Department) that our agricultural districts were falling too close to the 50% majority and a change was needed. Properties included within the greater than 50% majority are defined by the AFPB as “Viable” parcels for use in agricultural purposes.

While reviewing the agricultural districts, the AFPB and Planning Department found the inclusion of national stores such as Wal-Mart and Lowes within the agricultural districts. These properties had no reason to be included and were recommended to be removed.


A second issue discussed by the AFPB and Planning Department was the unorganized nature of the agricultural district boundaries, including some towns incorporated into multiple agricultural districts. Having multiple districts within a town made the district difficult to administer and confusing for those trying to identify which district a particular parcel was included in. For example, the Town of Pharsalia had two districts.

After much discussion, the AFPB and Planning Department decided on merging the existing six districts into three and adopting a new layout along municipal boundaries. The towns within each district would be chosen based on their geographic location and common features.


The first agricultural district of the new layout, Agricultural District #1A, was successfully reviewed, finalized, and accepted by the NYS Department of Agriculture and Markets in 2012 and 2019.

Agricultural District #2A, of which this report is based on, was the second district to be reviewed in the new layout. It was previously reviewed in 2014. The district is predominately located within the Towns of German, Lincklaen, McDonough, Otselic, Pharsalia, and Pitcher, grouped together due to the vast number of State-owned lands and low amounts of development pressures.

Agricultural District #3A was reviewed in 2016.

Summary of how Agricultural District #2A was reviewed

Step 1: When starting the review process of Agricultural District #2A, we first requested and obtained real property information from the Real Property Tax Department.

In years prior to 2010, worksheets were only sent to property owners whose properties were coded by town/village assessors as 100s, 321, 322, 323, or 900s. Some examples of these property codes include:

100 – Agricultural
105 – Farm Vacant Land
120 – Farm field crops
323 – Rural Vacant Land
910 – Private Forest Land

A full list of all property codes can be found on page 8.

Although the codes are still used during the review for reference purposes, worksheets are now sent to every property owner to acquire more accurate and up to date information. For Agricultural District #2A, worksheets were sent to approximately 900 property owners.

Step 2: As worksheets were returned, the Planning Department utilized Real Property Tax information and reviewed each worksheet. Based on the property code and information provided by the landowner on the worksheet, properties were determined as to their agricultural viability.

When reviewing Agricultural Districts, worksheets with phrases such as “Please Remove Me from the Agricultural District” or “No Reason to be in Agricultural District” written on them are deemed to be exclusions. Similarly, any publicly owned lands (i.e. New York State Forest Land), are also decided to be “Exclusions”.

A chart of the “Exclusions” for Agricultural District #2A can be found on page 7.

A 30-day period in which property owners could include their properties within the agricultural district was also held during from June 1st to June 30th. There were no requests from landowners in the district during this inclusion period.

A chart of the “Inclusions” can be found on page 7.

Step 3: Once all worksheets were returned, approximately 254 were received by the July 1st deadline, the Planning Department mapped the agricultural district including those properties deemed to be “viable” and “exclusions”.

Step 4: Using the below formula, and subtracting the exclusions, we obtained an agricultural concentration, or “viability”, within Agricultural District #2A of **66.64%**.

Agricultural Concentration Calculation (Viability) = the # of acres of agricultural land (code 100s) + residential (241) + abandoned/vacant land (321, 322, 323) + private forest acreage (900s) + acreage of lands deemed viable based on worksheet submissions, divided by the # of acres within the district.

Step 5: The updated Agricultural District will be presented to the Agriculture, Building & Grounds Committee on August 16th, 2022 and to the AFPB for approval on August 19th, 2022.

Step 6: The Planning Department will then present the updated Agricultural District #2A to the Board of Supervisors for their approval and hold a public hearing on September 12th, 2022.

Once approved by all required bodies, the Planning Department will send the final map to Cornell University for posting, review and approval. The Planning Department will send the final report and map to the Commissioner of NYS Agriculture and Markets for review and approval. After approval by both agencies, the map becomes an official Agricultural District Map.

Exclusions

After performing the agricultural district review we determined there was no exclusions.





Chenango County Agricultural District 2A

Conclusion

Agricultural District #2A again shows us that Chenango County has been, and continues to be, a viable farming community. While development pressures are not as severe within Agricultural District #2A comparative to other districts in the county, loss of viable agriculture and farmland still continues due to commercial and residential development pressures, fluctuating milk prices, and the effects of diminishing interest for farming by succeeding generations. As a result of the 2022 Agricultural District Review, we found a 4.96% loss in agriculturally viable land from the previous review in 2014.

As part of the 2012 Chenango County Agriculture and Farmland Protection Plan, the AFPB wrote a section denoting which lands should be protected; shown below. There are three categories of agricultural lands of which Chenango County wishes to protect:

- All areas currently viable for agricultural production with increased options for grazing and other activities for which most of our lands are suitable.
- Prime soils and soils of statewide importance located within the three primary river valleys and scattered throughout the County.
- Agricultural lands located along the main transportation corridors of NYS Routes 7, 8, 12 and 26, Interstate 88, and the Delaware and Hudson Railroad.

Chenango County lands currently viable in agricultural production are important to our farmers and residents for both economic and aesthetic reasons. Upland farms, where prime soils are less common, are well suited for increased grazing options such as raising cattle, horses, sheep and other livestock. In many locations these farms are also suitable for growing crops such as corn, hay, soybeans, oats and other grains, as well as small to medium scale fruit and vegetable production. These farms also provide the rural landscape and open space desired by residents.

Prime soils and those of statewide importance in Chenango County are located within the three primary river valleys and scattered throughout the county. These lands should be protected due to the high quality of the soil as well as the locations for which they are found. Prime soils are excellent for growing corn, hay and other crops which are essential for the dairy industry in Chenango County.

On the river bottom, allowing agricultural lands to stay in agriculture also provides a natural flood control measure. Flooding has been an increasing problem in recent years, including multiple 100-year floods in the last two decades. By keeping development out of these areas and allowing for agricultural uses instead, some of the negative effects of flooding can be lessened.

Chenango County also wishes to protect agricultural lands located along the main transportation corridors of NYS Routes 7, 8, and 12, Interstate 88, and the Delaware and Hudson Railroad. These corridors are particularly vulnerable to commercial and industrial development due to the level, well-drained nature of the land, its proximity to population centers, and availability of easy transportation routes. Although commercial and industrial development is necessary for strong communities, a balance is needed between protecting valuable farmlands and promoting economic development outside of agriculture. Development should complement agriculture; not replace it. Alternate sites (non-agricultural land sites) for industrial development should be the first choice for industrial development.

Threats to Chenango County agricultural lands come from two primary directions:

- The lack of economic/marketing opportunities for farm products.
- Industrial development on prime agricultural sites specific to regions close to major highways and the Delaware and Hudson Railroad.

In order to minimize these impacts and protect the valued agriculture and farmland in Chenango County, the Chenango County Agriculture and Farmland Protection Board strives to:

- Encourage the utilization and expansion of the local Farmers Markets.
- Provide assistance with market research and marketing of farm products.
- Expand access to regional markets from Central New York to the Eastern Seaboard.
- Include agricultural land protection with other industry development planning.
- Develop a mechanism to monitor rural development and provide for uniform reporting to County Government by Towns regarding applications for and approvals of agricultural land use changes.
- Educate Town and County Boards on creating comprehensive land use plans and the application of legal mechanisms for protection of farmland.
