New York State Public Health Rabies Law requires **all dogs, cats, and domesticated ferrets to receive immunization against Rabies no later than four months of age** and NYS Ag & Markets requires **dogs to be licensed at four months of age.**

Please read the following information: Pre-Registration Required.

- Must pre-register for the clinic. If you have difficulty registering for the clinic please call the Chenango County Environmental Health offices (607) 337-1673 for assistance.
- The clinic will be drive through for checking in, but the animals will need to be removed from the vehicle to receive the vaccination. Please limit passengers to only those necessary to control the animals (children should be left at home if at all possible).
- All animals must be on leashes or in carriers. Each dog must have its own collar.
- Please bring proof of previous vaccinations to the clinic.
- Driver and passengers must wear masks during the check in process and during the animals vaccination
- \$5 donation per animal suggested
