LOCAL LAW NO. 2 OF 1977

A LOCAL LAW of the County of Chenango, State of New York, pursuant to Article Two, Section ten of the Municipal Home Rule Law of the State of New York to establish residency and domiciliary employment eligibility qualifications for County Department Heads and Deputy Department Heads.

BE IT ENACTED, by the Board of Supervisors of the County of Chenango, State of New York, as follows:

Section 1. All employees of the County of Chenango, State of New York, whose employment position is designated as being a Department Head or Deputy Department Head, must be a resident of and be domiciled within the County of Chenango, State of New York, within a reasonable period of time of being appointed to such position, and must maintain such residency and domiciliary within the County of Chenango, State of New York, as long as he or she is employed in such position by the County of Chenango, State of New York.

Section 2. Nothing contained herein shall be construed to require any individual who is a Department Head or Deputy Department Head at the time of enactment of this law, who is not in compliance with the requirements herein, to move in order to comply with the provisions of this law.

Section 3. Nothing contained herein shall be construed to modify the residency qualifications contained in Article Two of the Public Officers Law of the State of New York.

Section 4. This law shall become effective upon filing of same with the Clerk of the Chenango County Board of Supervisors, the Department of State and the State Comptroller's Office.

Section 1. Section 4. This law shall become effective upon filing of same with the Clerk of the Chenango County Board of Supervisors, the Department of State and the State Comptroller's Office.
