LOCAL LAW NO. 1 OF 1983

A LOCAL LAW fixing the annual salaries of certain County Officers.

BE IT ENACTED by the Board of Supervisors of the County of Chenango,

Section 1. The flat annual salaries of the following named County Officers shall be in the amount set opposite each, to wit:

Commissioner of Social Services	\$36,500.00
County Superintendent of Highways	31,550.00
Director, Real Property Tax Service	24,350.00
County Treasurer	23,500.00
Personnel Officer	21,150.00
Commissioner of Elections (2) each	16,150.00

Section 2. The above specified salaries shall be effective on and after January second Nineteen Hundred and Eighty-three.

Section 3. This law shall be subject to a permissive referendum as provided in Section 24 of the Municipal Home Rule Law of the State of New York, but no petition for a referendum be filed, then this law shall become effective upon filing same with the Department of State and State Comptrollers Office.
