LOCAL LAW #1 OF 1991

A LOCAL LAW PROVIDING FOR PUBLIC NOTICE OF THE ADOPTION OF LOCAL LAWS
BY THE CHENANGO COUNTY BOARD OF SUPERVISORS

BE IT ENACTED BY THE Board of Supervisors of the County of Chenango, State of
New York as follows:

SECTION I. This Local Law of Chenango County shall be known as the
"Publication of Local Laws".

SECTION II. That notwithstanding the provisions of Section 27 of the Municipal
Home Rule Law and Section 214, Subdivision 2 of County Law, that the procedures set
forth in Section III hereof shall be the method established for public notice of
Local Laws adopted by the Chenango County Board of Supervisors.

SECTION III. Within 10 days after approval of a local law by the Board of
Supervisors, the Clerk of the Board shall cause to be published in the official
newspapers of the Chenango County Board a notice of adoption of a local law. The
notice of adoption of a local law shall be published once and shall contain a synopsis
of the law, and a notice that the full text of the law may be examined at the Office
of the Clerk of the Board during normal business hours.

SECTION IV. This local law shall take effect immediately upon full compliance
with all the requisite statutes and laws applicable to its adoption and promulgation.

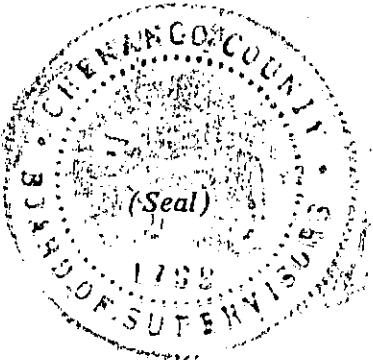
