LOCAL LAW #2 OF 1992

"A COUNTY LOCAL LAW AUTHORIZING CHENANGO COUNTY TO OBTAIN REIMBURSEMENT FOR THE
COST OF MEDICAL AND DENTAL CARE PROVIDED TO COUNTY JAIL INMATES HAVING THIRD PARTY
COVERAGE OR INDEMNIFICATION"

Be it enacted by the Chenango County Board of Supervisors as follows:

Section 1. Chapter 481 of the Laws of 1991 of the State of New York authorizes counties to enact a local law which would allow counties to be reimbursed for costs paid for medical or dental services provided to inmates of county jails from any third party coverage or indemnification carried by such inmates. This Board of Supervisors does hereby find that it is appropriate for the County of Chenango to seek whatever reimbursement is legally available for medical and dental care delivered to inmates of the County Jail. It is the intention of this Board of Supervisors in enacting this Local Law to enact the provisions of Section 500-h(2) of the Correction Law and thereby enable the County to be reimbursed for medical and dental care for certain inmates of the Chenango County Jail having third party coverage or indemnification.

Section 2. The County of Chenango, pursuant to Section 500-h(2) of the Correction Law as the same may be amended from time to time, is hereby authorized to obtain reimbursement for costs paid for medical and dental services delivered to inmates of the Chenango County Jail from any third party coverage or indemnification carried by an inmate.

Section 3. The Sheriff is empowered to adopt rules and regulations and take other actions as is necessary and proper to carry into effect this Local Law.

Section 4. This Local Law shall take effect immediately upon filing in accordance with the provisions of Municipal Home Rule Law.

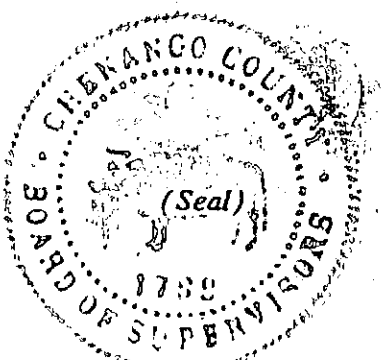
