A COUNTY LOCAL LAW ESTABLISHING A SECOND DEPUTY
COUNTY TREASURER POSITION

Be it enacted by the Chenango County Board of Supervisors as follows:

A LOCAL LAW ESTABLISHING A SECOND
DEPUTY COUNTY TREASURER POSITION

Section 1. **Authority:** This local law is enacted under authority of Section 10 of the Municipal Home Rule Law, and Sections 204 and 401 of the County Law of the State of New York.

Section 2. **Position Established:** A Second Deputy County Treasurer position is hereby established within the Chenango County Treasurer's Office. Such position shall be in the exempt class under the Civil Service Law of the State of New York.

Section 3: Appointment: The Second Deputy County Treasurer shall be appointed by and serve at the pleasure of the County Treasurer and possess the qualifications as the County Treasurer shall prescribe.

Section 4: Duties: The Second Deputy County Treasurer shall perform those duties assigned by the County Treasurer and in the event of a vacancy in the office or the absence or inability of the County Treasurer or Deputy County Treasurer, shall possess the powers and perform the duties of the County Treasurer.

Section 5: Designation of Order: The Treasurer shall pursuant to County Law 401(2), designate in writing the order in which his or her deputies are to serve during the Treasurer's absence or inability to act or vacancy in office.

Section 6: Effective Date: This law shall take effect immediately upon compliance with filing requirements of the Municipal Home Rule Law.

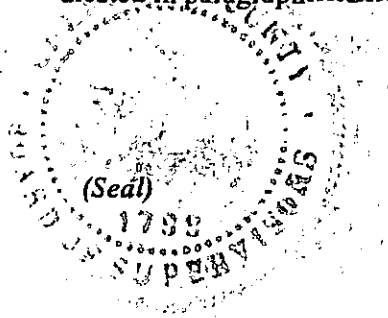
