as follows:

BE IT ENACTED, by the Board of Supervisors of Chenango County Board of Supervisors as follows:
Section 4.0 "Prohibited Acts" of LOCAL LAW NO. 2 OF 1989 as amended by LOCAL LAW NO. 5 OF 1991 and as further amended by LOCAL LAW NO. 2 OF 1993 is further amended by adding a new subdivision 4.3 to read as follows:

"4.3 Notwithstanding the provisions of Section 4.1 hereof, it shall not be a violation of this local law if solid waste resulting from the severe flooding in September of 2011 is accepted by Chenango County in its landfill and such flood related solid waste originates in Broome County and the disposal in Chenango County is pursuant to a written agreement between Chenango County and Broome County and such acceptance of solid waste will be in conformity with all applicable laws, regulations, permits governing the operation of the Chenango County Landfill and be it further provided that this amendment shall expire on December 30, 2011."




