A LOCAL LAW TO AMEND LOCAL LAW NO. 5 OF 1998, AS AMENDED BY LOCAL LAW NO. 2 OF 2016 "A COUNTY LOCAL LAW TO ESTABLISH A DEPARTMENT OF PUBLIC WORKS, AND TO MERGE THEREIN THE HIGHWAY DEPARTMENT AND THE DEPARTMENT OF WASTE MANAGEMENT"

BE IT ENACTED, by the Chenango County Board of Supervisors as follows:

Section 4(a), (b), and (c) of Local Law No. 5 of 1998, as amended by Local Law No. 2 of 2016 are further amended to read as follows:

Section 4. Deputy Director of Public Works.

(a) There are hereby created and established three offices of Deputy Directors of Public Works, all of which shall be in the exempt class of the civil service.

(b) The Deputy Directors of Public Works shall be appointed by and serve at the pleasure of the County Director of Public Works and possess the qualifications as the County Director of Public Works shall prescribe.

(c) The Deputy Directors of Public Works shall perform those duties assigned by the County Director of Public Works and in the event of a vacancy in the office or the absence or inability of the County Director of Public Works, shall possess the powers and perform the duties of the County Director of Public Works.

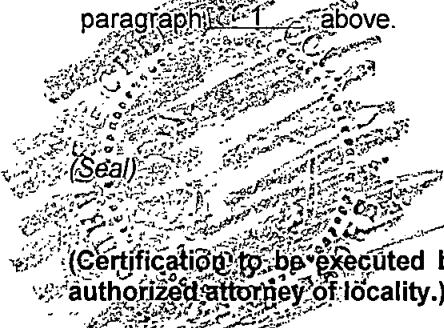




