LOCAL LAW NO. 1 OF 1960

A LOCAL LAW TO ESTABLISH CHENANGO COUNTY TAX DEPARTMENT.

Be it enacted by the Board of Supervisors of the County of Chenango as follows:

Section 1. A local law to establish Chenango County Tax Department under the provisions of sub. sec. 0 of Subdivision five of section three hundred one of the County Law.

Section 2. Said Department shall advise with and assist all Assessors, Collectors and Receivers of taxes of the various tax districts within the County in the discharge of the duties of their offices pursuant to rules and regulations as prescribed by the Board of Supervisors.

Section 3. Said Department shall assist in the preparation of the equalization table from rates established by the Board of Supervisors for the various tax districts within the County.

Section 4. Said Department shall assist in the disposition and sale of real property acquired by the County as a result of tax sales.

Section 5. Said Department shall prepare yearly abstract table and state reports in relation thereto.

Section 6. Said Department shall assist in preparation of delinquent tax records and billing of delinquent taxes.

Section 7. Said Department shall advise with and assist the following standing committees of the Board of Supervisors: Abstract, Assessment, County Lands, Equalization, Supervisors and Assessors and Unpaid School Tax Committees.

Section 8. Said department shall have such other duties as shall from time to time be delegated to it by the Board of Supervisors.

Section 9. This Local Law shall take effect on June 1, 1960.

COUNTY OF CHENANGO

LOCAL LAW NO. 2 of 1960

A LOCAL LAW fixing the annual salaries of certain county officers.

BE IT ENACTED by the board of supervisors of the county of Chenango as follows:

Section 1. The annual salaries of the following named county officers shall be the amount set opposite each, to wit:

Children's Court judge	\$4,000.00
County Clerk	6,500.00
County Treasurer	6,500.00
Sheriff	8,000.00
County Attorney	3,500.00
Superintendent of Highways	6,000.00
Member of board of supervisors	1,700.00
Chairman of board of supervisors	800.00
Commissioner of public welfare	6,000.00
Commissioner of elections	1,700.00
Member of civil service commission	300.00
County Historian	700.00
Director of Civil Defense	1,200.00
County service officer (veterans)	3,800.00
Administrator of county self insurance plan	700.00
Director of tax department	4,800.00

S2. The above specified salaries shall be effective on and after January one, nineteen hundred sixty-one.

S3. The salaries of the commissioner of public welfare and of the sheriff hereinbefore specified shall each be considered to contain an annual allowance of one thousand eight hundred dollars for maintenance consisting of room and board at the county welfare home and at the sheriff's residence respectively. Should the commissioner of public welfare not reside at the county welfare home his maintenance shall not be provided elsewhere but in such event his salary shall not be decreased.

S4. The salary of the chairman of the board of supervisors shall be paid in addition to his salary as a member of such board.

S5. No annual increment for time of service shall be added to the salaries specified in section one.

S6. This law shall be subject to a permissive referendum as provided in subdivision five of section three hundred five of the county law, but should no petition for a referendum be filed, then this law shall become effective on the first day of January nineteen hundred sixty-one.
