STATE OF NEW YORK COUNTY OF CHENANGO LOCAL LAW NO. 3 of 1963

A LOCAL LAW fixing the annual salaries of certain county officers.

BE IT ENACTED by the Board of Supervisors of the County of Chenango as follows:

SECTION 1. The flat annual salaries of the following named county officers shall be the amount set opposite each, to wit:

County Treasurer	\$7,190.00
Commissioner of Elections	\$2,249.00

§2. The above specified salaries shall be effective on and after January second, nineteen hundred and sixty-four.

§3. No annual increment for time of service shall be added to the salaries specified in section one.

§4. This law shall be subject to a permissive referendum as provided in subdivision five of section three hundred five of the county law, but should no petition for a referendum be filed, then this law shall become effective on the second day of January nineteen hundred sixty-four.

State of New York County of Chenango Local Law No.3 of 1978

A local law abolishing the offices of Coroner in the County of Chenango and creating the Office of Medical Examiner.

Be it enacted by the Board of Supervisors of the County of Chenango as follows:

Section I. The offices of Coroner in the County of Chenango be and the same hereby are abolished. The terms of office of all coroners elected and holding office in the County of Chenango at the time this local law becomes effective shall expire upon the appointment and qualification of the medical examiner.

Section II. The office of Medical Examiner in the County of Chenango is hereby created.

Section III. This local law is subject to referendum on petition as provided by law and shall become effective upon filing in the office of the Secretary of State as provided by the Municipal Home Rule Law (but in no event shall it become effective sooner than the first day of January, 1979).

Seconded by Mr. Chairino and duly adopted.

I hereby certify that the Local Law annexed hereto, designated as Local Law No. 3 of 1978 for the County of Chenango entitled "A Local Law abolishing the Offices of Coroner in the County of Chenango and creating the Office of Medical Examiner" was duly passed by the Board of Supervisors on April 10, 1978. Such local law being subject to a permissive referendum and no petition requesting such referendum having been filed, said local law was deemed duly adopted on May 31, 1978, in accordance with the applicable provisions of law.
