**Section 1. There is hereby established a Traffic Safety Board for Chenango County.**

**Section 2. The said Board shall be composed of fifteen members who shall be appointed by the Board of Supervisors of Chenango County pursuant to the provisions of Article 43 of the Vehicle and Traffic Law of New York State.**

**Section 3. The said Board shall have the functions and authority as provided in the provisions of Article 43 of the Vehicle and Traffic Law of New York State as amended.**

**Section 4. This Local Law shall become effective on the 1st day of March, 1958.**

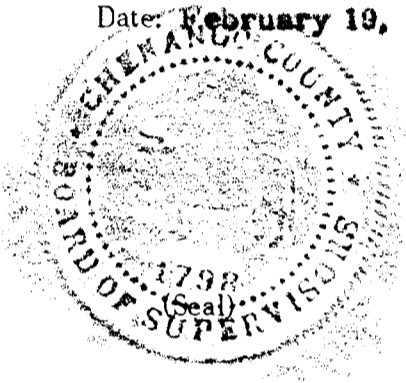
