LOCAL LAW NO. 1 OF 1971  
OF CHENANGO COUNTY  
Requiring all snowmobiles operated on roads  
and other lands in Chenango County to carry  
proof of financial responsibility.

SECTION I. Legislative Intent The purpose of this Local Law is to protect the public health, welfare and safety by regulating the operation of snowmobiles within Chenango County and requiring proof of financial liability so as to protect the operators of said snowmobiles and the general public.

SECTION II. Legislative Authority This Local Law is enacted pursuant to the provisions of Article 8 of the Conservation Law as enacted by Chapter 459 of the Laws of 1970.

SECTION III. Short Title This Local Law shall hereafter be known and cited as the County of Chenango Snowmobile Financial Responsibility Local Law.

SECTION IV. Financial Security It shall be unlawful for any person to operate a snowmobile on any road or highway or any lands whatsoever within Chenango County other than by an owner or his immediate family on lands belonging to or leased by him unless such person is insured against public liability and carries with him proof of financial responsibility, such as a certificate of liability insurance of the type, coverage and of the minimum amount as defined and required of owners and operators of motor vehicles by the Vehicle and Traffic Law of the State of New York. Such proof shall be displayed by the owner or operator of any snowmobile upon request to any law enforcement officer or to any person who has suffered or claims to have suffered either personal injury or damage to property as a result of the operation of such snowmobile by any such owner or operator.

SECTION V. Violations Failure to comply with any of the provisions of this Local Law shall be deemed a violation and the violator shall be liable

for a fine of not less than \$25 nor more than \$200 and for a second violation, a fine of not less than \$50 nor more than \$300.

SECTION VI. Effective Date This Local Law shall be effective immediately except that no snowmobiles shall be operated under the authority hereof until such time as the State Office of Parks and Recreation and/or the State Department of Transportation adopt rules and regulations with respect to Article 8 of the Conservation Law and until said Article 8 is effective.

SECTION VII. Validity If any section, sub-section, paragraph, clause, sentence or phrase of this Local Law is for any reason held invalid or unconstitutional by any court of competent jurisdiction, such portion shall be deemed a separate, distinct and independent provision and such holding shall not affect the validity of the remaining portion thereof.
