State of New York County of Chenango Local Law No.3 of 1978

A local law abolishing the offices of Coroner in the County of Chenango and creating the Office of Medical Examiner.

Be it enacted by the Board of Supervisors of the County of Chenango as follows:

Section I. The offices of Coroner in the County of Chenango be and the same hereby are abolished. The terms of office of all coroners elected and holding office in the County of Chenango at the time this local law becomes effective shall expire upon the appointment and qualification of the medical examiner.

Section II. The office of Medical Examiner in the County of Chenango is hereby created.

Section III. This local law is subject to referendum on petition as provided by law and shall become effective upon filing in the office of the Secretary of State as provided by the Municipal Home Rule Law (but in no event shall it become effective sooner than the first day of January, 1979).

Seconded by Mr. Chairino and duly adopted.

I hereby certify that the Local Law annexed hereto, designated as Local Law No. 3 of 1978 for the County of Chenango entitled "A Local Law abolishing the Offices of Coroner in the County of Chenango and creating the Office of Medical Examiner" was duly passed by the Board of Supervisors on April 10, 1978.
