LOCAL LAW No. 3 OF 1980  
A LOCAL LAW AMENDING LOCAL LAW No. 4  
OF THE YEAR 1972 AND AUTHORIZING A RE-  
DISTRIBUTION OF VOTES BETWEEN DISTRICT  
NO. 1 AND DISTRICT No. 2 IN THE CITY OF  
NORWICH

BE IT ENACTED by the Board of Supervisors of the County of  
Chenango as follows:

Local Law No. 4 of the year 1972, County of Chenango, New York,  
is hereby amended as follows:

SECTION 1. Section 3., subdivision e of said Local Law is  
hereby amended to provide that the total votes for the City of  
Norwich District 1 and District 2 as set forth in columns B.,  
C. and D. shall be divided between the Districts in such manner  
as the Common Council of the City of Norwich shall determine by  
proper resolution duly enacted but that in no event shall said  
division as to District No. 1 be any less than the votes attributed  
to said District in Columns B., C., and D. in said Local Law No. 4  
of the year 1972.

SECTION 2. Except as herein amended, said Local Law No. 4 of  
1972 shall in all respects remain in full force and effect.

SECTION 3. This Local Law shall be subject to a permissive  
referendum as provided in Section 24 of the Municipal Home Rule Law  
of the State of New York, as amended, but if no petition for a  
referendum be filed, then this law shall become effective upon  
filing same with the Department of State.
