A COUNTY LAW PROHIBITING LITTERING IN CHENANGO COUNTY AND AMENDING LOCAL LAW NO.4 OF 1994.

Be in enacted by the Board of Supervisors of the County of Chenango as follows:

SECTION 1: ARTICLE V: ADMINISTRATIVE SANCTIONS Section 7(k) of Chenango

County Local Law No. 4 of 1994 shall be amended to read as follows: "All surcharges or penalties shall be payable to the Chenango County Treasurer. The Treasurer shall disburse such surcharges or penalties upon collection to the town, village or city undertaking and prosecuting the enforcement action. If the enforcement action was taken and prosecuted by the County of Chenango the money shall be utilized by the County for waste management purposes."

SECTION 2: ARTICLE VII: JUDICIAL SANCTIONS Section 9(e) of Chenango County

Local Law No. 4 of 1994 shall be amended to read as follows: "All civil penalties or sanctions shall be payable directly to the Chenango County Treasurer. The Treasurer shall disburse such

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civil penalties or sanctions upon collection to the town, village or city undertaking and prosecuting the enforcement action. If the enforcement action was taken and prosecuted by the County of Chenango the money shall be utilized by the County for waste management purposes.”


