ADOPTED LOCAL LAW NO. 4 OF 1999

A LOCAL LAW AMENDING THE ANNUAL SALARIES OF THE DIRECTOR OF PUBLIC WORKS AND THE COUNTY TREASURER FOR THE YEAR 1999

BE IT ENACTED, by the Board of Supervisors of Chenango County.

Section 1. The Chenango County Board of Supervisors, by prior Board action, has established additional duties and responsibilities for the office of Director of Public Works and the office of County Treasurer.

Section 2. It has been determined that additional compensation shall be granted to said officers as a result of said responsibilities.

Section 3. The flat rate annual salary of the Chenango County Director of Public Works for the year 1999 shall be increased from \$57,620.00 to \$59,660.00, retroactive to January 1, 1999.

Section 4. The flat rate annual salary of the Chenango County Treasurer shall be increased from \$42,626.00 to \$45,126.00, with said change to be effective July 1, 1999.

Section 5. This law shall be subject to a permissive referendum as provided in Section 24 of the Municipal Home Rule Law of the State of New York, but if no petition for a referendum be filed, then this law shall become effective upon filing same with the Department of State.

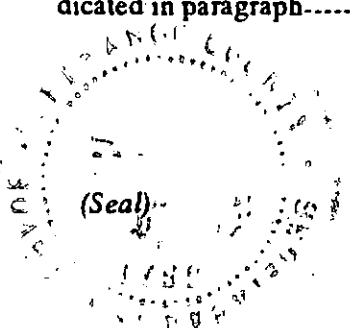
